CALL TO ORDER - Chairman Randall Malichi called the meeting to order at 8:05 am.

INVOCATION - Chairman Randall Malichi delivered an invocation.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u> – The January 2018 minutes were reviewed by the Board. Andy Rogers made a motion to approve the minutes as presented and the motion was seconded. The Board unanimously agreed to approve the January minutes.

Chairman Malichi noted the MCEDP Board had lost a staunch member, Ken Harmon. He called for a moment of silence.

<u>WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT UPDATE</u> – Deputy Superintindent Dr. Rippin McLeod spoke on behalf of Dr. John Lane who was unable to attend due to a conference. He noted that the school district had a presentation prepared but asked that it be placed on hold until the new superintendent was fully in place effective July 25<sup>th</sup>.

<u>INDUSTRY APPRECIATION DAY</u> – Executive Director Ron Munnerlyn explained a new format planned for the event to occur on September 13<sup>th</sup>.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Membership – Executive Director Ron Munnerlyn explained that the membership drive is about to begin.

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Welding Booth Expenditure Approval – Executive Director Munnerlyn asked the Board to approve an expenditure of \$6,109.68 for the equipment. Luke Johnakin made a motion to spend \$6,109.68 for the welding booth. The motion was seconded and the Board unanimously approved the equipment purchase.

Approval of 2018-19 Budget – Executive Director Munnerlyn explained proposed budget changes for the upcoming year. Andy Rogers made a motion to approve the proposed budget and the motion was seconded. The Board unanimously agreed to approve the 2018-2019 budget.

<u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u> – The January through May 2018 financial reports were circulated and there were no items of note.

## **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

- Outlined NETC tour
- Noted the final approval of two incentive packages for industrial expansion showing that the County industries are growing and competitive
- O Andy Rogers explained the Palmetto Brick expansion project.
- o Arauco is doing a warehouse expansion
- O Unemployment rate is the lowest it has been in forty years
- The County has title to the Delta Mills site and there is a redevelopment plan in motion. The building is in really good shape to be used as a speculative building. Outlined infrastructure present.
- o Council passed the County budget with a focus on not increasing taxes
- Voted to put on the ballot in the general election to be able to sell alcohol on Sundays since the County has been losing tax revenue
- One prospect has serious interest in the Boro site

<u>ADJOURNMENT</u> – Chairman Malichi made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded. The meeting was adjourned for reconvening at the Former Winn Dixie.
